

AGREEMENT FOR SCHOOL

AGREEMENT FOR PARENTS/CARERS

TO HELP MY CHILD AT SCHOOL, I WILL:

- see that my child attends school regularly, on time, and wearing the St. Robert's school uniform
- notify school if my child cannot attend
- talk to the school if my child is worried about attending school or if something happens to affect my child's learning

- attend meetings and discussions about my child's progress
- talk to my child about their experiences in school and encourage them to do their best
- support my child with their homework and other opportunities for learning at home
- regularly listen to my child read at home
