

BISHOP BEWICK TRUST CONSULTATION: On Monday 27th September a 3 week consultation will begin. It is a consultation to convert to Academy status and join the Bishop Bewick Catholic Education Trust (formerly Sacred Heart Partnership of Schools). FREE SCHOOL MEALS: All pupils in reception, year one, and year two are entitled to a free meal, without having to apply for this option. However, if you are on any form of benefit you may be eligible to apply for free school meals and this means that the school would receive extra funding. ADMISSIONS: Applications into Middle (Y5), Secondary (Y7) and High School (Y9) for September 2022 entry opened on 12th September. Please log on via the NCC website and apply before 31st October. Applications received after 31st October will be classed as 'late' and will not be processed until all 'on time' applications have been allocated. Online Admissions Portal for Reception admissions will open on the 1st of November 2021.

BIRTHDAY TREATS: Over the years we have always allowed birthday sweets/cakes to be shared with the class as part of your child celebrating their birthday. We have made the decision to stop this for the following reasons: we now have a significant amount of pupils with food allergies in school, the pressure and cost it can put on some families to share sweets with 30 pupils and as a healthy school it goes against what we are trying to promote. I can appreciate this might be difficult for the children to understand, so I will explain it to them in Monday's Liturgy. Thank you for your support and understanding.

FLU VACCINES: Pupils in Reception to Year 4 whose parents have given consent, will receive the nasal flu vaccine on Monday 20th September.

NATIONAL FITNESS DAY: To mark National Fitness Day all pupils can come to school in their PE kits on Wednesday 22nd September. They will complete a short fitness activity every hour to mark the day. Activities include: running, dancing, skipping and aerobics.
