PARENT CONSULTATION EVENINGS: On Tuesday/Thursday afternoons the first virtual parents evenings were held. Thank you to all the parents who joined the class teachers online to discuss their child.

SWIMMING: We are delighted that Year 3 are able to have a term of swimming, starting on Monday 12th April. Please make sure you send your child with their swimming kit in on Mondays. We will arrange for the current Y3 children to go swimming for the first two terms in Year 4 so that they complete the required curriculum time. Year 4 will go swimming in the Summer term on Thursday afternoons as they missed a term last year, this will start on Thursday 15th April in the afternoon and they will need to bring their swimming kits in on a Thursday please.

BIKEABILITY: We are very excited to have arranged for The Cycle Partnership, funded by the Council, to come and deliver bike riding courses for all children in the school. The first Balance sessions are for Nursery and Reception and will be Monday 12th to Thursday 15th April for 45 minutes in groups of 6. Balance bikes and helmets will be provided, but children can bring their own in if they want to. Year 4 will undertake Level 1 (children need to be able to ride a bike) on Friday 16th April. This session is for 1hour 30mins and the class will be split into two groups of 15, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Children will need to bring bikes and helmets for this course. If you do not want your child to undertake Bikeability or have any queries, please contact Mrs Perkins. Details of the sessions for the other years will follow.

SPORTS CLUBS: We are pleased to announce that Tennis with Mariana Warwick (Year 4) and Multi-Skills with Liz Ions (Year 3) as well as the Multi Sports Club (Year 2 for first 3 weeks of term) will start after school in the week commencing 12th April. All clubs run until 4.15pm.


