

EARLY YEARS PARENTS MEETING: We are holding a meeting on Tuesday 5th October at 9.30am for Nursery and Reception parents/carers to explain the new curriculum and give you the opportunity to explore both classroom environments and ask any questions to help support your child with their learning.

NAMES ON SCHOOL CLOTHING AND WATER BOTTLES: can parents and carers please ensure that their child's name (or family name) is on their jumpers and cardigans. The same applies to water bottles. FREE SCHOOL MEALS: All pupils in reception, year one, and year two are entitled to a free meal, without having to apply for this. However, if you are on any form of benefit you may be eligible to apply for free school meals and this means that the school would receive extra funding. This also entitles your child to free school milk after the age of 5.

ADMISSIONS: Applications into Middle (Y5), Secondary (Y7) and High School (Y9) for September 2022 entry opened on 12th September. Please log on via the NCC website and apply before 31st October. Applications received after 31st October will be classed as 'late' and will not be processed until all 'on time' applications have been allocated.
