CONSULTATION REGARDING ORGANISATION OF ST BENEDICT'S RC VA MIDDLE SCHOOL AND ST AIDAN'S RC FIRST Change to St Benedict's Published Admission Number (PAN)

As you know, plans the future organisation of St Benedict's RC VA Middle School and St Aidan's RC First School within the Ashington partnership are currently being consulted upon, and this will have implications for children leaving St Robert's at the end of Year 4 whose parents wish them to continue their education in the Catholic system. Also, St Benedict's sent out a letter on 7 July 2016 (previously circulated and copy attached) explaining that, due to the fall in their school roll over recent years, they are applying to reduce the Published Admission Number (PAN) from 60 to 30, from September 2016 onwards.

The Governors of St Robert's have been assured by the Diocese that there will be places available in Year 5 within the Ashington partnership of Catholic schools (this includes Bedlington schools) for children of St Robert's families wishing to continue their Catholic education. If you intend to send your child through the Catholic system, please respond to the consultation with your views (consultation document and response form attached).

'DAY OF THE DISAPPEARED' PEACE GARDEN COMMEMORATION – Invitation to St Robert's Families

The Red Cross will commemorate the Day of the Disappeared in the Peace Garden on Tuesday 30th August at 4pm, with a brief ceremony involving planting a rosemary bush for remembrance. St Robert's children and families are invited to attend. This Day is kept internationally especially to remember children separated from their families while having to flee from their country because of war or hunger. Many people, including the Red Cross, are trying to help find these children and bring them home.
