Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children all receive free school meals. Cost for Year 3 and Year 4 children remains £2.20 per day (£11 per week)

HEALTH AND SAFETY RULES

- Please remember to put some all day sun lotion on your child before the trip. They may also bring some sun lotion to apply themselves under adult supervision during the day. Sun hats are also essential.
- Children are not allowed to swim, therefore swimsuits are not allowed on the trip.
- Children will be taken down to the sea to paddle (up to their knees) class by class and will be called when it is their turn. They will be constantly supervised. As this is a school trip, no children should be in the water at other times.
- Children will be assigned an adult for the day. The adult will ensure that they take the child to the beach and from the beach to the coaches.
- Children should only play on the beach. They must not go into the dunes.
- Each child should sit with their adult at picnic time.
- The children will travel on the same bus as their adult.
- <u>All children should bring a waterproof jacket</u>.

The children do not need to wear school uniform, just suitable clothes for a day out at the beach, **bearing in mind it may be chilly**, with a change of clothes in case of splashes! They should bring a small bag to carry their belongings. <u>Don't forget packed lunches and a bucket and spade</u>

Remember – any photographs you take on the trip are solely for private use of parents and family.

ALL THE CHILDREN MUST TRAVEL ON THE BUS TO NEWTON AND BACK TO SCHOOL.
