PARENT CONSULTATION EVENINGS: We will not be having our usual parent consultation meetings at the beginning of October. This meeting would have been to discuss how your child has settled into their new class. Instead we will aim to produce individual short videos which will be sent to you via the portfolio section on Class Dojo. I will send further details about this next week. CAR PARK: I need to remind all parents that the carpark is NOT to be used between 8:30am and 3:30pm for drop off or pick up. The car park needs to be kept clear so that the taxis can access the site to drop off and collect children. **STAFF VISORS:** You or your child may see staff wearing visors while in school. One of the lessons that has been learnt from positive cases at other schools is that staff are more likely to spread the infection between themselves. In order to prevent this and keep all staff safe visors have been issued to all staff members and will be worn when a 2m distance can not be maintained between staff from other bubbles or from parents. Thank you for your support. **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** A reminder to all parents and carers that we expect you to wear face covering whilst on site at any time and to maintain social distancing. Thank you for continuing to support us with this measure. **CLIMBING WALL:** The climbing wall is only being used by Y1 as it falls on their allocated part of the yard. Please make sure that only Y1 children are using it before and after school.

**FLU VACCINE FORMS:** Thank you to all those parents who have completed and returned the forms to school to inform us whether or not you want the immunisation for your child. If you have not yet done this, please can you do so by Monday 21st September.

**ADMISSIONS:** Applications into Middle (Y5) school for September 2021 entry have opened. Please log on via the NCC website and apply before 31st October. Applications received after 31st October will be classed as 'late' and will not be processed until all 'on time' applications have been allocated.
