All clothing should have child's name clearly marked. All children in years 1 to 4 should also have suitable outdoor PE kits every Thursday as PE will take place outside (weather permitting).

MEDICAL FORMS: Please complete and send back to school if your child's medical needs have changed. Please also ensure that all medication in school is up to date for the new school year. Please note, the medical forms are for serious and persistent medical conditions, for which we would need to store medicine in school, and administer in case of an emergency.

REQUESTING A LEAVE OF ABSENCE: Any parent wishing to remove their child from school for whatever reason is now asked to complete a request for absence form and meet with Mr Sutcliffe. Please remember, Government guidelines are very clear that leave of absence may only be granted in very exceptional circumstances, and it is at the discretion of the Headteacher to consider each case on an individual basis. Request forms will be available from the School Office.
