

Next week's Statement to live by: I try to appreciate the beauty and wonder in the world around me.

THANK YOU: Thank you to all parents and carers for your support this half term. It has been our most challenging since Covid arrived due to the level of pupil and staff absences. As a school we really appreciate your continued support and understanding. We hope that life in school will return to normal in the coming weeks as the guidance from the government changes.

COVID UPDATE: For the first time in 3 months we are delighted to tell you that we do not have any children (and only have one member of Staff) off with Covid. For your information, the current guidance is that if your child has symptoms, please take them for a PCR test (not a LFD test at home). If someone else in the household is positive, test your child for 7 days with LFD tests. If any of these (or a PCR test) is positive the child must self isolate for 10 days, or until they have 2 consecutive negative LFD tests (starting on day 5 and 6) whichever is soonest. They can return to school on day 6 if they have had 2 negative tests and do not have a temperature. **Please be aware that these guidelines may change over half-term.**

NON SCHOOL UNIFORM DAY: We raised £128 for the Place2Be children's mental health charity by having a non-uniform day last Friday. Thank you so much for your support.

ROYAL MAIL DELIVERY OFFICE WORK: You may have been aware at pick up that the Royal Mail are having work carried out on their site. This has caused noise and disruption (and some damage) in school this week. We were not informed of the work and can only apologise for the disturbance caused to our pupils. As a consequence of the vibrations, we need to have the climbing wall assessed by a Surveyor and the children are not be able to use it until we have been told that it is safe. Please do not allow siblings to use it at pick up/drop off.


