COVID UPDATE: Covid infection rates have increased since Christmas. We will inform you on a weekly basis of the number of positive tests in each class. The table shows the confirmed cases in school at the time of writing (the staff and pupils who are currently isolating). COVID MEASURES: We continue to keep the children in bubbles of phases (NUR/REC; Y1/2 and Y3/4) Most the of the time classes remain in individual class bubbles, other than outside at break and lunchtime where they play in their phase bubbles. meet virtually for prayer and celebration assembly. In order to reduce the spread of infection, the government now recommends that anyone aged 5 years and over who is a close contact of someone with COVID-19 takes daily lateral flow tests for 7 days. LFD tests are to be used by people without COVID-19 symptoms to pick up asymptomatic cases. If someone tests positive on an LFD test without symptoms they do not need confirmation by PCR test and should follow the self-isolation procedure as if it had been a PCR test. Anyone who has one of the core symptoms of COVID-19 – a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to sense of smell or taste - should self-isolate and go for a PCR test. They must continue to self-isolate if they get a positive PCR test result, even if they have had a recent negative lateral flow test. If you or your child tests positive on a lateral flow device (LFD) test you should self-isolate immediately and register your result on GOV.UK so that NHS Test and Trace can trace your contacts. In line with the reduced self-isolation guidance, anyone who tests positive can leave self-isolation 6 days after the date of their initial positive test if they receive 2 negative LFD results, 24 hours apart, on days 5 and 6. If still positive they need to continue to isolate until 2 negative tests or their 10 days is up.
