**THE DAILY MILE:** This term, children in Y1-4 will take part in a one mile challenge organised by The School Run. (<a href="www.ukschoolrun.com">www.ukschoolrun.com</a>) Promoting physical activity is currently high on the government's agenda given the increasing rates of obesity amongst our younger population. In 2018, the much publicised sugar tax started to provide schools with a £415 million levy to invest further in school sport and increase levels physical activity and promote healthy lifestyles.

At St Robert's we recognise the importance of promoting regular physical activity and we have embraced this exciting challenge by running the daily mile.

Year 1—4 will be running the daily mile on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019 and each year group will run their mile throughout the day. They will then receive a medal at a Celebration Assembly. The medals have cost the school £1.99 and we are asking for a donation of £1 per child towards the cost. This is now on Gateway for you to pay, please or you can send the £1 in with your child. Thank you!
