COVID UPDATE: The table shows the confirmed cases in school at the time of writing (the staff and pupils who are currently isolating). Current guidance is that if your child has symptoms, please take them for a PCR test (not a LFD at home). If someone else in the household is positive, test your child for 7 days with LFD tests. If any of these (or a PCR test) is positive the child must self isolate for 10 days, or until they have 2 consecutive negative LFD tests (starting on day 5 and 6) whichever is soonest. They can return to school on day 6 if they have had 2 negative tests and do not have a temperature.


