WRAP AROUND DROP OFF: After the half term break we are going to trial a new drop off system for wrap around care in the morning. The school gates to the yard from the car park will be open from 7:45am until 8:30am and parents can drive in through the car park onto the yard, drop their child off and then drive out of the gates at the front of the school. Please drive slowly and carefully.

PET HQ: Please DO NOT park along the side of Pet HQ, these are not spaces for parents to use to drop their children off. Thank you.

NSPCC ASSEMBLIES: This week each class has used the PANTS resources as part of the PSHE curriculum.
