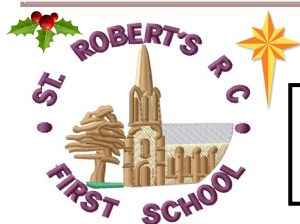

CRIB BLESSING: It was lovely to have our annual crib blessing. Mr Sutcliffe shared an idea with the children which everyone might like to do. On the third Sunday of Advent (Bambinelli Sunday) in St Peter's Square Rome, Pope Francis will bless the figures of baby Jesus from everyone's nativity scene. The figures of baby Jesus are taken home and wrapped up and placed under the tree. It should then be the first gift the family opens on Christmas morning and placed into the crib.
